MODULE 2 – CREATE A PRO TOOLS SESSION AND AUDIO TRACKS

1. Create a new folder on the Firewire drive called: “Student Last Name” 2600. The “create new folder” command is found in the file menu. The short cut is: shift, apple, N.
2. Launch Pro Tools from the Doc. Drag your mouse to the bottom or side of the screen in order to locate the doc.
3. From the file menu, create a new session in Pro Tools with the following criteria:
 - The bit rate must be 24 bit.
 - The sample rate must be 48kHz.
 - The default audio file format must be .wav.
 - Choose enforce Windows compatibility.
4. Name the session: Student last name_Calle_M2 and save it to your folder in the Firewire drive on the computer desktop.
5. Create and label the following mono tracks.
 - Click
 - Kick
 - Snare
 - Hi hat
 - Crash
 - Bass
 - Voice over
 - Flute
 - Trumpet
 - Trombone
 - Tenor Sax
 - Baritone Sax
6. Create the following stereo tracks:
 - Acoustic piano
 - Electric piano
 - Acoustic Guitar
 - Distorted guitar
 - Pads
 - Strings

7. Create the following auxiliary tracks:
 - Voice reverb
 - Brass reverb
8. Check your work. Save your session. Quit Pro Tools.
