Module 3 – Importing a midi file into a Pro Tools session.

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### **MODULE 3 – IMPORTING A MIDI FILE INTO A PRO TOOLS SESSION**

1. Open the session named: “student last name” 2600 M2.
2. From the File menu, choose “import MIDI file.” Choose “import tempo from file.”
3. Set the MIDI channel out for the MIDI tracks as follows:
  - Click - 10
  - Kick - 10
  - Snare - 10
  - Hi hat - 10
  - Crash - 10
  - Bass - 1
  - Flute - 11
  - Trumpet - 12
  - Trombone - 13
  - Tenor Sax - 14
  - Baritone Sax - 15
  - Ac piano - 2
  - El piano - 3
  - Ac Guitar - 4
  - Dist guitar - 5
  - Pads - 6
  - Strings - 7
4. Create a Master Fader track if you have not already done so.
5. Check your work.
6. Save your session as: “student last name 2600 M3” in your folder on the Firewire drive.
7. Quit Pro Tools.
